Entry-level child protection workers must have a BSW or MSW from an accredited school of social work. Other requirements include a valid Ontario Driver's Licence, access to a car with appropriate insurance and a vulnerable sector police check. Credit is given for child welfare experience.

In addition to offering a competitive benefits package that includes a comprehensive health, dental, life and LTD benefits package, participation in the OMERS pension plan, and twenty (20) days of paid vacation per year, you will have an opportunity to work and develop your skills under the supervision of Social Work professionals with years of Child Protection experience.

Unauthorized Child Protection Workers who are offered employment contracts will be enrolled in the OACAS authorization program and have the opportunity to become Authorized Child Protection Workers.

Start dates will vary depending on the staffing needs of the Agency.
